1 package of salts will make approx. 40 gallons of ~50% Holtfreter's Solution

Directions:

1. Fully dissolve salts in a pitcher of HOT water.
2. Pour dissolved salts into a filling 40 gallon barrel of cool water.
 - We use Rubbermaid trash barrels for our water.
3. If you are using tap-water, you will need to remove chlorine and chloramines with a good water-conditioner (such as Kordon's AmQuel). At this time, you can also add a skin-conditioning ingredient (like Kordon's NovAqua)
 - Removing Chlorine/Chloramines is not necessary if you are using distilled water, or well-water.
 - Do not just let your water sit overnight to de-chlorinate on its own. Chloramines do not evaporate out and require chemical removal.
4. Typical housing water temperature is: 15-18°C (60-65°F)
